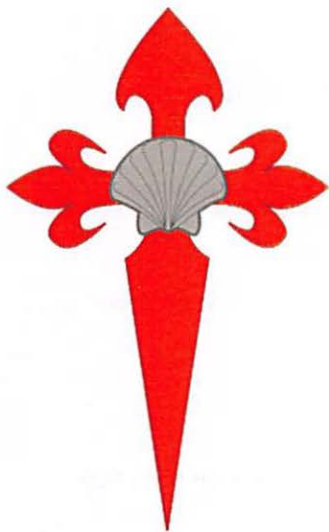

Regular Services and Activities at St James

Sunday

8.30am – Traditional Said Holy Communion (short half hour service)

10.00am – Parish Family Eucharist (60-70 minute service with Choir and coffee served afterwards. Although liturgical and formal this is a relaxed service and children and dogs are both warmly welcomed!)

6.30pm – Sung Evensong (traditional language prayer service and beautiful sung choral music - service length 50-60 minutes)

11am – Breathe – 1 hour free Christian mindfulness and meditation class for healing and wholeness

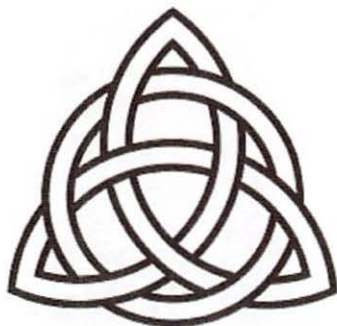

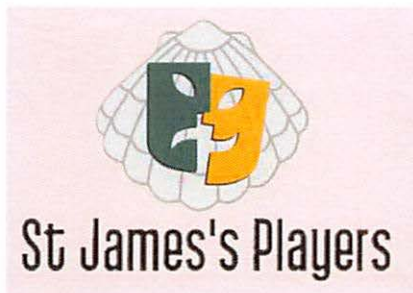
